

Community Assets and Resources

1. Historic District and historic heritage. Many beautiful, architecturally significant buildings still intact (e.g., Block Barn, Railroad Freight House, Historic Palmer Opera House.)
2. Natural beauty of the area
3. Excellent library in a beautiful, new structure (Cuba Circulating Library)
4. Good quality school with high educational standards
5. Nice recreational parks and strong community sports programs
6. Community newspaper for
7. New, attractive fire hall.
8. Cuba Memorial Hospital with urgent care service (Most small communities lack medical facilities) and a skilled nursing home. Good access to medical professionals and supplies (doctors, dentists, rehabilitation facilities, veterinarians, two pharmacies)
9. Two banks in the community
10. Two fitness centers in the community
11. Tourist attractions include Cuba Cheese Shoppe, Cuba Cheese Museum, Cuba Historical Museum, community festivals (i.e., Dairy Week, Garlic Festival, Alpaca Festival), Moonwinks Restaurant; private and public land attract deer hunters, Cuba Lake attracts boaters and anglers, Maple Lane RV camp, private camps.
12. Quality-of-life businesses in Town (full-sized grocery store, bank, barbershop/beauty shop, hardware store, pharmacies, bakery, restaurants, etc. (Many small communities lack many of these types of businesses.)
13. I-86 Interchange (close proximity and quick and easy access / with public water and (soon) sanitary sewer service available.
14. Recreational facilities (Willow Bank Park, Chamberlain Park, Genesee Park, Cuba Elementary School softball diamond and play field, soon to be constructed pedestrian trail linkage to Genesee Valley Greenway Trail, Cuba Lake, Seneca Oil Springs Park) Nearby by golf courses (Waterway Hills, Six S, Serenity Hills, Allegheny Hills).
15. Cuba Community Development Corporation (CCDC) which obtains and administers programs to assist low and moderate income homeowners to make improvements to their homes.
16. Railroad Freight Service (WNY&P) rail siding and trans-load facility.
17. Abundant supply of high-quality water.
18. Amish farm goods and products produced in the area.
19. Cuba Feed Store
20. Strong and active churches that perform community work
21. Cuba is on Allegany County Antique Trail
22. Community recognized as a Tree City USA by the Arbor Day Foundation due to the significant number of trees planted each year.
