NOTICE REFUSE & RECYCLING SCHEDULE YEAR 2020

Part of Section 170-4 of the Code of Cuba Village, requirements for curbside placements collection schedule:

All residents using the Village Service shall have such material, **on the day of collection only**, at curbside by **7:00 am** and all places of businesses shall have such material at rear of building, if possible, to be collected by **9:00 am**. The maximum weight of any single item left for collection, except bulk items, including the weight of the container, shall be **fifty (50) pounds** for refuse & recycling.

Residential customers will have their refuse collected on Thursday of each week

****EXCEPT THE WEEK OF THANKSGIVING, CHRISTMAS EVE, AND NEW YEAR'S EVE, WHICH WILL BE PICKED UP THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE.****

Notice of changes will be put in the local newspapers and posted at the village hall.

THE BUSINESS DISTRICT WILL BE COLLECTED ON MONDAYS AND THURSDAYS, INCLUDING LABOR DAY AND MEMORIAL DAY.

Recycling for both residential and business customers will be the **SECOND (2ND) AND FOURTH (4TH) THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH.** Cardboard should be broken down and either tied in bundles, placed in paper bags or cardboard boxes. The schedule for recycling collection is listed below:

White goods or bulk items such as domestic appliances and furniture will be collected the **first Thursday** of each month unless on a Holiday, then collection will be the Wednesday prior. **Brush/branches will be collected on the first Monday of each month unless on a Holiday, then the Tuesday following.** If you notice garbage being brought into the Village from outside of the Village **PLEASE NOTIFY US.**

(BRUSH RULES ON BACK)

NOTICE
BRUSH TO BE PICKED UP

1. All brush shall be at the curbside by 7:00 am the day of pickup.
2. All brush placed at curb to be no longer than six feet in length.
3. All brush to be securely bundled and tied. Bundles shall be of a size and weight that can be handled by one person.
4. All brush to be bundled with all butt-ends heading the same direction.
5. All brush to be put at curb shall have no larger than a four-inch diameter.
6. Quantity of brush to be put at curb shall be limited to its intent for residential pick-up. Special arrangements shall be made of large quantities with the Superintendent of Public Works at 585-968-2487.
7. Contractors shall be required to dispose of all brush and material created as a result of work being performed.
8. All materials that are not being chipped such as bark, twigs, leaves and pine needles shall be put at curb in containers.
9. Containers can consist of plastic bags, garbage cans and bushel baskets.
10. DO NOT have garbage mixed in with brush to be picked up.
11. NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL- OR RECYCLABLES ARE COLLECTED ON THIS DAY.

LEAF PICK UP RULES

DO NOT MOW GRASS OR RAKE LEAVES INTO STREET AS THEY END UP PLUGGING UP THE STORM DRAIN SYSTEM.

Leaves will be picked up from the time that there are enough leaves to warrant getting the “leaf vac” hooked up until the day before Veteran’s Day. After that time all leaves will need to be bagged and put to the curb and then the leaves will be picked up on the first Monday of the month on our regular monthly brush day. Please separate garbage and pet waste from leaves prior to picking up. Animal waste is a health hazard to our village employees.

If residents do not abide by the above rules their brush, twigs, leaves, etc. will be left at the curb.

IF ANYTIME YOU NOTICE THAT YOUR WATER IS DISCOLORED, OR YOUR PRESSURE HAS DROPPED, PLEASE CALL 585-968-2487 SO WE CAN CHECK ON IT AS THESE ARE INDICATORS THAT WE HAVE A LEAK SOMEWHERE.
