Mayor Michele Miller called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm in the Village of Cuba Board Room at 17 E Main St Cuba, NY 14727.

Mayor Miller stated the deadline to become a partner with the Letchworth Gateway Villages is tomorrow 7/28/21. The Cuba- Rushford School, The Cuba Chamber, the Town of Cuba and the Cuba Friends/ Palmer Opera House have committed \$1,000 each. The group needs a portion of the commitment to participate in the Genesee Valley Trail Town Initiative which is a total of \$5,000. Mayor Miller said if approved, the funds could come out of the parks contractual line, and if the line looks to go over, there is money in the contingency line and the board could amend the budget and specify the use out of contingency.

TRUSTEE RAUB MADE A MOTION TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR THE FUNDS FOR THE LETCHWORTH GATEWAY VILLAGES WITH TRUSTEE TAYLOR OFFERING A SECOND. ALL IN FAVOR AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

TRUSTEE RAUB MADE A MOTION TO COMMIT \$1,000 AS THE VILLAGE'S SHARE IN FUNDING ANNUALLY FOR THE NEXT FOUR YEARS TO THE LETCHWORTH TRAIL TOWN INITIATIVE WITH TRUSTEE BARNES OFFERING A SECOND. ALL IN FAVOR AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

TRUSTEE BARNES MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN WITH TRUSTEE RAUB OFFERING A SECOND. ALL IN FAVOR AND THE MEETING ADJOURNED AT 5:04 PM.
