**Patrolman Austin Plank**

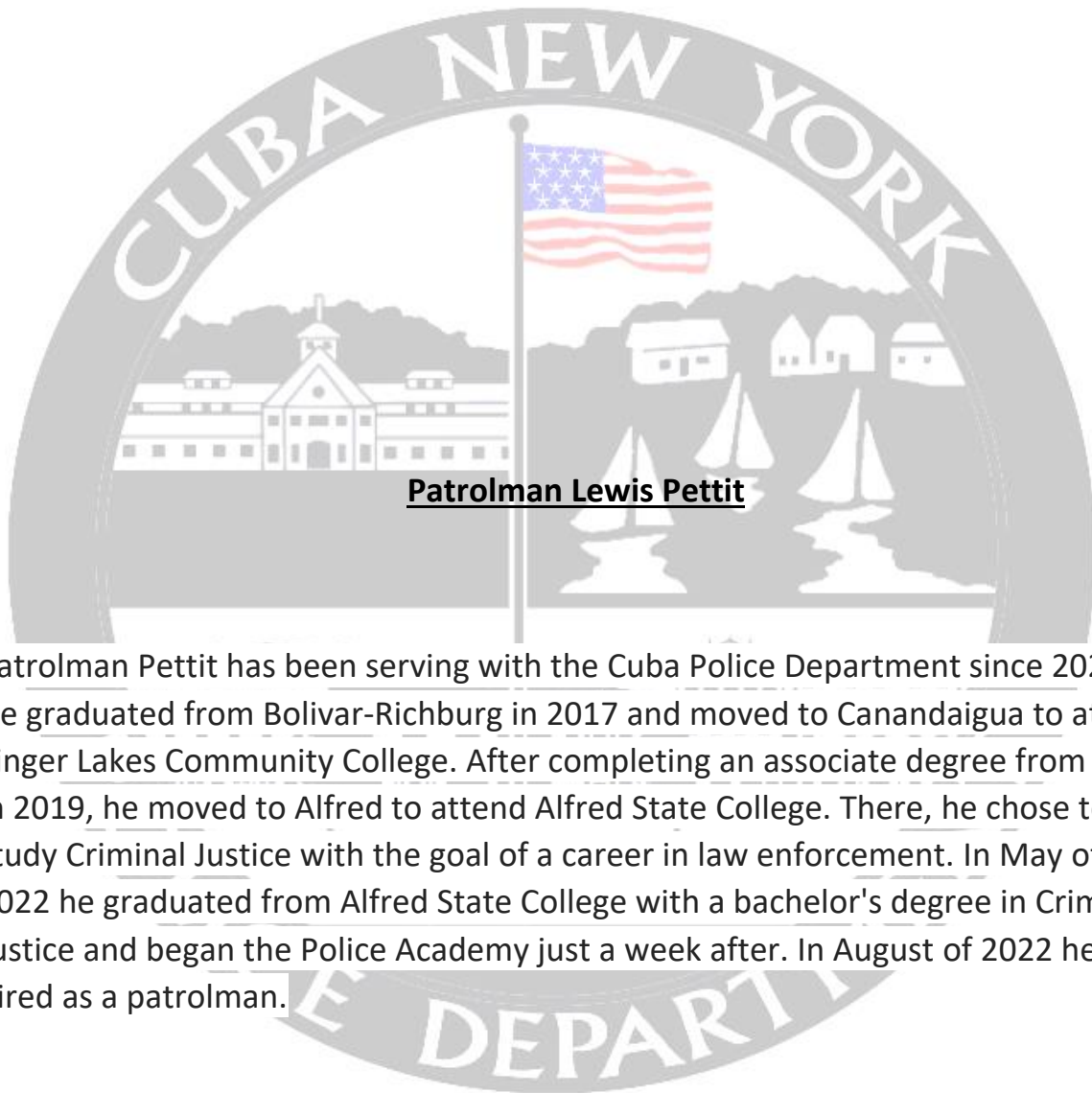

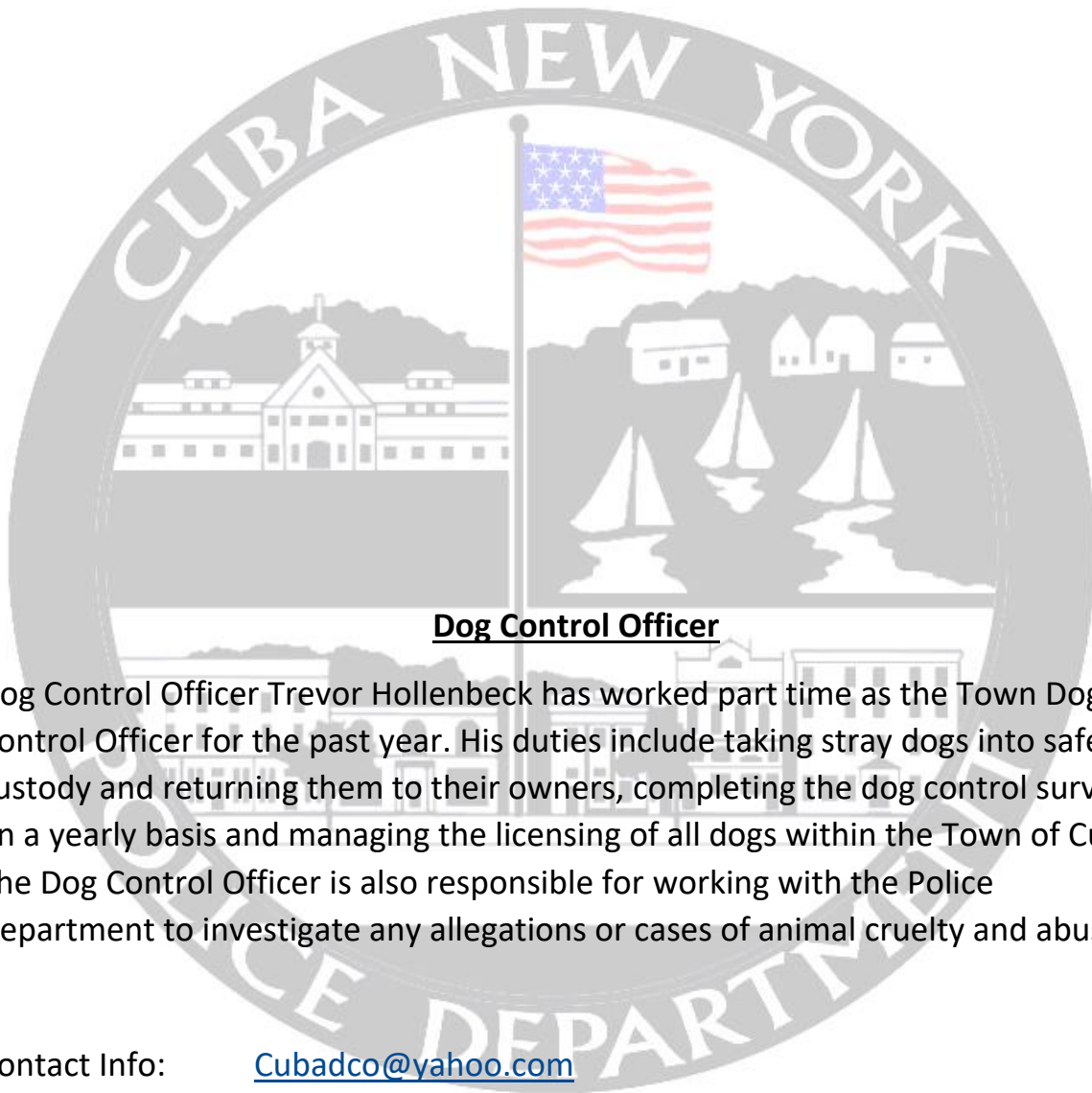


**Patrolman Lewis Pettit**
