



Local Laws

The Village of Cuba has many unique laws and ordinances that new residents may not be familiar with. The local laws are spirited to promote all residents to be good neighbors. Below is a list of some of these laws and the penalty each carries. For more information or a copy of the Village laws stop by the police department or the Village Clerk's office during normal business hours.

Parking

- No parking on Main Street for more than 2 hours from 8am-5pm – Vehicle subject to tow at owner's expense.
- No parking on Village streets and Town roads from 2am - 6am, Nov 1 thru May 1 - \$25 fine.

Local Laws

- Open Container - no person shall possess an open container of or consume an alcoholic beverage on any public lands within the Village and Town of Cuba - \$50 minimum fine
- Disturbing the peace - No person(s) shall: use obscene or abusive language or gesture in a public place - congregate with other persons in a public place and refuse to comply with a lawful order of the police to disperse - obstruct pedestrian or vehicular traffic - fine \$50 to \$250
- Noise Law - No person shall operate or permit to be operated any mechanical or electronic device for the production or amplification of sound in such a way that it produces unnecessary noise. - \$50 to \$250 fine
- Fire Law - No person shall kindle or maintain an outdoor fire within the boundaries of the Village of Cuba unless it is an approved container (*outdoor fireplace, metal or clay chimnea, manufactured metal fire pit with a mesh cover*). - \$50 to \$250 fine.
