

REVISED SOLID WASTE RULES – EFFECTIVE  
\_09\_/\_01\_/\_2020\_\_\_ Applies to Chapter 170, §170-4,  
Issued pursuant to §170-0

1. Each household is limited to four (4) 30-32 gallon containers (50 lbs. ea. Max.).

Note: Approved containers shall be provided by the property owner, as required by 308.3.1 of the International Property Maintenance Code adopted by New York State:

a. All containers shall be in good repair and have tight fitting covers b. One (1) of the above may contain construction debris, must be covered. 2. Multiple dwellings (3 or more units) may have a covered dumpster, provided by the Owners

a. Size shall be to accommodate the needs of the Tenants and approved by the

Superintendent of Public Works prior to installation. (Typical Load for a 2 cu.yd is 400 lbs ea.) b. All dumpsters shall be in an enclosed area, accessible to the Refuse truck, and protected from damage. Such dumpsters must be approved by the Village Superintendent of Public Works as compatible with the Village refuse removal equipment before installation will be allowed. c. Enclosures shall also be able to accommodate the recycling needs of the Tenants

on recycling day. 3. Building Owner(s) must make arrangements to dispose of tenant leftovers (furniture,

appliances, electronics, etc.) Such material left curbside will NOT be collected by the Village refuse crew. 4. Large quantities of construction debris shall be removed from the site by the building Owner or Contractor, and disposed of in conformance with all applicable laws and regulations. 5. No electronic items (computers, monitors, TV's, printers, etc.) will be picked up - the

Owner/Tenant is responsible for such disposables in accordance to applicable laws and regulations.
