

**REVISED SOLID WASTE RULES- EFFECTIVE 01/01/2023**  
**Applies to Chapter 170, §170-4, Issued pursuant to §170-0**

1. Each household is limited to three (3) 30–32-gallon containers (50 lbs. ea. Max.).  
Note: Approved containers shall be provided by the property owner, as required by §308.3.1 of the International Property Maintenance Code adopted by New York State:
  - a. All containers shall be in good repair and have tight-fitting covers.
  - b. One (1) of the above may contain construction debris, must be covered
2. Building owner(s) must make arrangements to dispose of (furniture, electronics, etc.). Such material left curbside will NOT be collected.
3. Large quantities of construction debris shall be removed from the site by the building owner or contractor and disposed of in conformance with all applicable laws and regulations.
4. No electronic items (computers, monitors, TV's, printers, etc.) will be picked up. The owner/ tenant is responsible for such disposal in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Any apartment building that has more than five (5) units is not included in the Village contract and the owner must make arrangements for refuse and recycling collection from the building in conformance with all applicable laws and regulations.
6. Any business that generates more than three (3) 30–32-gallon containers of solid waste as specified above is not included in the Village contract and must make arrangements for refuse and recycling collection from the building in conformance with all applicable laws and regulations.
